

## Financial Assistance

Subsidies are available for students who require funding support to purchase a PLD. Please note that it is compulsory for all students on the MOE Financial Assistance Scheme (FAS) to use their Edusave to pay for any remaining sums due for the PLD, after subsidies have been granted.

Please see the table below for information on the eligibility for the subsidy:

<b>Students eligible for subsidy</b>	<b>Income criteria</b>	<b>How to Apply for Subsidy</b>
Students under MOE FAS	Gross Household Income (“ <b>GHI</b> ”) is \$4,000 or less, or Per Capita Income (“ <b>PCI</b> ”) * is \$1,000 or less	No action required. Automatically subsidised for the PLD.
Students under School-based FAS	<b>GHI</b> is \$5,500 or less, or <b>PCI</b> is \$1,375 or less	Approach the school’s General Office to apply for a subsidy.
Students who are currently <u>not</u> under the MOE FAS or School-based FAS	<b>GHI</b> is \$5,500 or less, or <b>PCI</b> is \$1,375 or less	Approach the school’s General Office to apply for a subsidy.

\* **PCI** refers to the *GHI* divided by the total number of family members in the household.

For International Students (IS) and Students who are Permanent Residents (PR) and whose **GHI** is below \$5,500 or **PCI** is below \$1,375, you can apply for subsidies for your PLD. Please approach the school when the letter to purchase the PLD is issued.
